A true American tragedy is underway and most know little or nothing about it. I pray that this letter will not only enlighten every reader, but move you to help before it's too late. I've sent this to subscribers of my newsletter, business associates, friends and family. I'm literally begging anyone who has benefited from my newsletter and friendship to answer this call in a big way.

During this holiday period of joy, tens of thousands of good men and women are suffering and dying for doing nothing more than being courageous and wanting to help their fellow human beings. Good deeds have turned into life and death struggles for thousands who risked their lives on America's darkest day – 9/11.

On September 11, 2001, the world was horrified by terrorist attacks in the United States. Almost immediately, the bombing site we came to know as “Ground Zero” became the main focus of this tragedy. Forty-thousand (yes, 40,000) men and women rushed to Ground Zero in hope of rescuing strangers, friends and co-workers. Even when it became apparent that few, if any, survived, most stayed in hope of honoring the dead by recovering their bodies.

During this period, government officials repeat-



edly stated that it was safe for the rescuers to continue their efforts. And, by opening up Wall Street again, the 9/11 responders were encouraged that everything must be okay since the stock exchange was allowed to operate. Little did they know how bad a decision their government had made, (and the jury's still out on whether it was done knowingly). The first responders – police, fire fighters, construction workers, EMTs, EMS, and “average Joe” volunteers from across the country – are now paying dearly with losses of health, jobs, homes and even more: life itself. Of the 40,000 first responders, an estimated 70 percent, or 33,000, are now sick or have died.

Herein lies the rub: each family of a 9/11 victims, those who died in the attacks, received an average of \$2.6 million from the \$7 billion September 11<sup>th</sup> Victims' Compensation Fund. Yet, most 9/11 responders were left behind. Although some of the sick and injured received average payouts of \$463,000, the fund **ONLY COMPENSATED THOSE INJURED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 16<sup>th</sup>!!!** So, those responders who were hurt later (like John Feal, who was injured on the 17<sup>th</sup> of September and subsequently had his foot amputated) and those who later developed a plethora of cancers and breathing ailments and the need for organ donations ... well, they received nothing from the fund. These heroes were told they did not qualify because day or months—or in John's case, a mere 48 hours—had passed.

**How unconscionable? Could this be so?** Sadly, it is. And, what makes this nightmare worse is that not only are they being disregarded financially, but they receive none of the dignity, respect, gratitude or compassion they so justly deserve from the people and government they selflessly assisted. It's just unthinkable.

This tragedy has to stop and I have been blessed to find a genuine American hero who is doing just that.

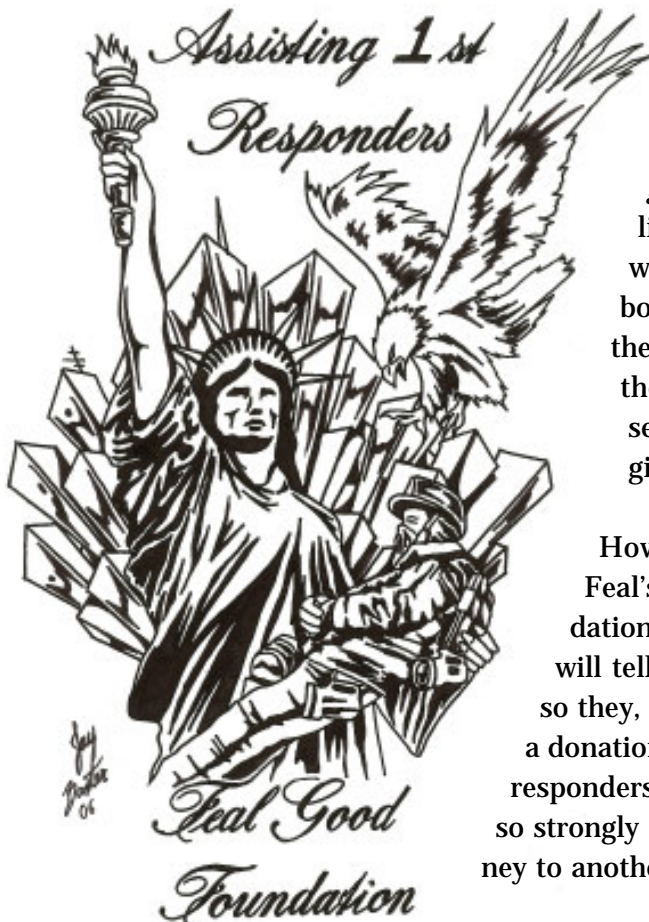
